Now draw your own heart. What will you make it look like as you prepare to give it to Jesus?




The Heart

We will be able to love as Jesus loves. We will be able to love even when it is hard to do so!




The Flames


The Sacred Heart of Jesus is surrounded by flames. How beautiful it looks! How glorious!
